Bright Spot Initiative

- ❖ Michigan Public Health Institute Center for Health Equity Practice (CHEP) in collaboration with the Southeast Michigan Hospital Collaborative (SEMIHC), will increase enrollment in the DPP among Black individuals in Metro Detroit.
- ❖ NACDD -> MDHHS -> MPHI -> SEMIHC
- ❖ Aug 2022- July 2023
 - ❖ Additional year of funding through July 2024

Bright Spot Initiative Highlights Y1

- ❖ Community Champions
 - ❖ Community and Coaches Surveys
 - ❖ 73 community survey participants
 - ❖ #1 motivating factor was health care provider referral
 - ❖ Barrier to participating: Program too long
 - ❖ 23 coaches survey participants
 - ❖ Desired additional training (engage men in DPP, equity, behavior change models)
 - ❖ Improve financial incentives for Coaches
- ❖ Landscape Analysis
 - ❖ Need for improving the provider referral infrastructure and processes,
 - ❖ Need for enhancing a supportive environment for lifestyle coaches
